- **1. Employer:** Heliwild LLC located in Austin, Texas. Phone 979-203-6735. We will NOT utilize any agent or recruiter for the recruitment of H-2B workers under this Application for Temporary Employment.
- 2. Job Information: 1 (one) Wildlife Capture Helicopter Pilot needed for seasonal, temporary, full time employment.
- **3. Job Duties and requirements:** The pilot includes flying a helicopter for helicopter net gun capture, chemical capture, coral capture, telemetry tracking and predator depredation. Employer will offer 40 hours of work, Monday through Sunday, between 7-4 PM, depending on weather. Travel is a requirement. Worker is needed to begin work on 10/01/2020 through 4/30/2021. Requirements:

High School diploma and Helicopter Pilot License

24 months of training in wildlife capture

24 months experience in wildlife capture (5 month season = 5 years)

2500 hours wildlife capture experience, must include net gun, chemical and mass capture.

1000 hours high altitude experience

500 hours low level flight below 100 ft

Must have caught over 15 large game species species of wildlife

Rated in MD500D and R44 helicopters.

Must be able to lift 200 lbs.

Must be prepared to fly exclusively for Heliwild LLC. and sign a non compete company contract.

- **4. Worksite Locations**: Work will be performed in multiple worksites throughout the State of Utah including the counties of Toole, San Juan, Wasatch, Duchesne and Uintah. There is no physical address since the job takes place in different mountainous areas of Utah.
- **5. Wage Offer:** Workers will be paid no less than \$40.00 per hour. On weather days, when no work is performed, workers will be paid no less than \$20.00 per hour.
- **6. Over Time:** Overtime will not be offered.
- **7. On the job training:** Employer will not offer on the job training.
- 8. Single Workweek for Pay: The employer will use a single workweek as its standard for computing wages due.
- 9. Frequency of Pay: Workers will be paid bi-weekly by check or bank deposit.
- **10. Provision of Board/Lodging or Other Facilities**: The employer will assist the employee to secure board and lodging at a reasonable cost.
- **11. Deductions from the Worker's Paycheck:** The employer will make all deductions from the worker's paycheck required by law as well as a reasonable cost for board and lodging.
- **12. Transportation:** The employer will be reimbursed for transportation and subsistence, at least \$12.68 per day during travel to a maximum of \$55.00 per day with receipts, from the place the worker has come to work for the employer, whether in the US or abroad, to the place of employment, if the worker completes 50 percent of the period of employment covered by the job order, consistent with 20 CFR 655.20 (j)(1)(i).
- 13. Return Transportation: The employer will provide or pay for the workers cost of return transportation and daily subsistence, at least \$12.68 per day during travel to a maximum of \$55.00 per with receipts, form the place of employment to the place from which the worker, disregarding intervening employments, departed to work for the employer, if the worker completes the certified period of employment or is dismissed from employment for any reason by the employer before the of the period, consistent with 655.20(j)(1)(ii)
- **14. Daily Transportation:** The employer will provide daily transportation to and from worksite.
- **15. First Work Week Reimbursement:** The Employer will reimburse the H-2B worker in the first workweek for all visa, visa processing, border crossing and other related fees, including those mandated by the government, incurred by the H-2B worker.
- **16. Provision of Tools, Supplies and Equipment:** The employer will provide workers at no charge, nor deposit, all tools, supplies and equipment required to perform the duties assigned, in accordance with 20 CFR 655.20(k)
