The employee will have duties typically associated with a position of this nature. The tasks and responsibilities will include caring for one child. The employee will transport the children to activities, appointments, etc., as necessary. The employee needs to have a patient personality and a love for children. As a byproduct of this responsibility, the employee will use items such as car seats, strollers, booster seats, high chairs, nail clippers, baby medication, etc. The employee will have some inevitable duties such as washing the children's clothing, cleaning areas of the house that they will eat, play, and sleep in each day.

Work is to begin October 15, 2022 and the ending date is October 14, 2024.

Work will be in Smyrna, Georgia. Worker will be a temporary full-time worker. Employee's expected daily schedule will be eleven hours per day, five days per week, from 6:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m, Monday through Sunday. Employees will be paid \$12.36 per hour. A single work week will be used for computing wages due. Should worker require overtime pay, the overtime pay rate will be \$18.54 per hour. Paychecks will be issued every week, on a Friday. The Employer will make all deductions from the worker's paycheck that are required by law. Lodging will be available in employer-owned housing at no additional cost to the employee.

As applicable, the employer will reimburse in the first work week all visa, visa processing, border crossing, and other related fees, as mandated by the government and not exceeding the mandated reimbursements. The employer will provide workers at no charge all tools, supplies, and equipment required to perform the job.

If the worker completes 50% of the work contract period, employer will reimburse the worker for transportation and subsistence. Upon completion of the work contract or where the worker is dismissed earlier, employer will provide or pay for employee's reasonable costs of return transportation and subsistence back home or to the place the worker originally departed to work, except where the worker will not return due to subsequent employment with another employer. The amount of transportation payment or reimbursement will be equal to the most economical and reasonable provided at a rate of \$14.00 per day during travel to a maximum of \$59.00 per day with receipts.
