Let out or take in seams in garments to improve fit using industrial sewing machine. Make garment style changes, such as tapering pant legs. Measure parts such as sleeves or pant legs, and mark or pin-fold alteration lines. Must have 3 months of tailoring experience and be able to operate an industrial sewing machine. 10 temporary, full-time positions 10/15/22 – 06/15/23, 8am – 5pm, Mon-Fri. Will work at 2 locations in Austin, TX: 2707 Walsh Tarlton Lane, and 724A N. Lamar Blvd.

H-2B Application concurrently filed concerning these positions. Wages: \$15.42 per/hr. OT available at \$23.13 per/hr. Single workweek will be used in computing wages due. Pay period every two weeks. Employer will make all deductions from worker's paycheck required by law. Transportation (including meals and, to the extent necessary lodging) to the place of employment will be provided, or its cost to worker reimbursed, if the worker completes half the employment period. If the worker completes 50% of the work contract period, employer will reimburse the worker, by company check, for transportation and subsistence from the place of recruitment to the place of work. Upon completion of the work contract or where the worker is dismissed earlier, employer will provide or pay for the worker's reasonable costs of return transportation and subsistence back home or to the place the worker originally departed to work, except where the worker will not return due to subsequent employment with another employer. The amount of transportation payment or reimbursement will be equal to the most economical and reasonable common carrier for the distances involved. Daily subsistence will be provided at a rate of \$14.00 per day during travel to a maximum of \$59.00 per day with receipts. Reimbursement in the first workweek for all visa, visa processing, border crossing, and other related fees, including those mandated by the government, incurred by the H-2B worker (but need not include passport expenses or other charges primarily for the benefit of the worker). Employer will provide worker at no charge all tools, supplies, and equipment required to perform the job. The employer guarantees to offer work for hours equal to at least three-fourths of the workdays in each 12-week period of the total employment period.
