Position Duties:

Dishwashers/Busser/Runner will be responsible for cleaning dishes, kitchen, food preparation equipment, and utensils; facilitate food service by cleaning tables, removing dirty dishes, replacing soiled table linens, setting tables, replenishing supply of clean linens, silverware, glassware, and dishes; bring items such as water, condiments, and coffee to patrons; bring food and beverages to patrons at tables.

Rate of Pay: \$15.04/hour + DOE (The employer will pay or exceed the prevailing wage, as determined by the US Dept of Labor)
Hours per Week: 40 (OT is possible, to be paid at \$22.56/hour + DOE).

Single workweek will be used to compute wages due. All deductions from the worker's paycheck required by law will be made. Workers will be paid every week by check.

Return transportation will be provided if the worker completes the employment period or is dismissed early by the employer. In other words, if the worker completes 50% of the work contract period, employer will reimburse the worker for transportation and subsistence from the place of recruitment to the place of work by check separate from payroll.

Upon completion of the work contract period, or where the employee is dismissed earlier, the employer will provide or pay for the worker's reasonable cost of return transportation and subsistence back home or the place the worker originally departed to work, except where the worker will not return due to subsequent employment with another employer.

The amount of transportation payment or reimbursement will be equal to the most economical and reasonable common carrier for the distances involved. Daily subsistence will be provided at a rate of \$14.00 per day during travel to a maximum of \$59.00 per day with receipts. The employer guarantees to offer work for hours equal to at least three-fourths of the workdays in each 12-week period of the total employment period.

H-2B workers will be reimbursed in the first work week all visa, visa processing, border crossing, and other related fees, including those mandated by the government (excluding passport fees).

The employer will provide workers at no charge all tools, supplies, and equipment required to perform the job.
