Terms & Conditions of Employment: Workers will be paid no less than \$10.87 per hour. Employer will apply any applicable overtime as needed and will be paid at a rate of 1.5 times base hourly rate. Employer will use a single work week (Saturday–Friday) as its standard for computing wages. Employer will offer 40 hours of work per week, depending on weather conditions. Monday through Friday. Work on weekends may be required. Hourly work schedule is 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Transportation: Employer will book and pay directly for travel to provide transportation from and returning to worker's place of residence as well as provide travel subsistence at a minimum daily rate of \$15.46 to a maximum of \$59.00 per day with receipts.
